Warm up Jackpot Friday, September 8th **Entries must be Postmarked By September 2nd, 2017.**

OFFICIAL RULES

1. NBHA, and BBR Rules of Conduct will apply.
2. Futurity is open to any horse foaled in 2012 or later. Derby is open to any horse foaled in 2010 or 2011.
3. All futurity or derby horses must be checked in before 10am Saturday September 9th, 2017. Failure to check in will result in the horse/rider combination being ineligible to compete.
4. Check in will not be allowed unless payment has been made in full, the entry form has been completed and proof of horse's age has been provided.
5. Entry form, one time payment and copy of registration papers or veterinarian proof of age is due on or before September 2nd, 2017. Failure to submit required paperwork will be considered an invalid entry. **Late fees will be determined by POSTMARK, not meter date, and will be accepted with a \$20 late fee per person. Late entries will be CASH ONLY.**
6. Late entries will be accepted until 10:00 AM Saturday September 9th, 2017. Be prepared to leave a copy of your necessary paperwork with the Office for Futurity and Derby Horses. Open, Youth, PeeWee and Senior late entries will be accepted until 12:00 pm.
7. NO REFUNDS for any reason. No Vet Release. NO EXCEPTIONS. Riders may sell spots.
8. Participants do not have to be NBHA members or BBR members to compete. Participants may enter more than one horse. Times will be for each horse/rider combination.
9. Futurity and Derby will be separate races on a 3D format with 1 second split. Open, Youth and Senior will be on a ½, ½, 1 second split 4D format.
10. Target Time may be entered in all divisions except Pee Wee. No combination of times allowed ie both runs must be in the same division, cannot count the open from one day and youth from the other. If running a horse in 2 events and entering the target race, must specify which race will be for the target time prior to the first horse running in the open. If nothing is specified, the entry will default to the times run in the open.
11. A three-call rule will be implemented. If you have not entered the arena by the time your name has been called three times, it will be an automatic disqualification.
12. The run order will be a **RANDOM** draw of pre-entries for **all** races BOTH DAYS. Late entries will be random draw after pre-entries.
13. Horse/rider combinations must be run in the order drawn.
14. A knocked over barrel, loss of forward motion or broken pattern will result in a disqualification of that run..
15. 75% of the entry fees will go into the purse.
16. Payouts will be based on the NBHA payout schedule.
17. Substitutions are allowed only due to illness, injury or death of nominated horse. A veterinarian's affidavit of proof MUST accompany substitutions along with a \$25 fee. Substituted entries must present copy of registration papers or veterinarian proof of age at the time of substitution.
18. Long sleeved shirt with collar, boots and hats or helmets are required as we will have a photographer. Failure to wear proper attire will result in a disqualification. Hat fine of \$15.00 will be enforced! Hats will be kept in the office until fine is paid. Must be paid before your next run.
19. All dogs must be kept on a leash. **There will be no dogs and no smoking in the arena building.**
20. The Futurity Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor for unsportsmanlike conduct, abuse of a horse, harassment of show officials or other such conduct deemed to be disruptive or detrimental to the operation of the event by the competitor or anyone associated with the competitor i.e. spouse, children etc.
21. Youth contestants may enter Youth Race or Pee Wee Race but not both.
22. If contestants wish to be stalled together, entries must be mailed together in same envelope. All horses must be stalled or penned, NO TIE OUTS OR PERSONAL PENS per SCAAC rules.
23. Exhibitions will tickets from the office. Exhibitions \$5.00 each. 60 second time limit.
24. ALL DECISIONS OF THE FUTURITY COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.
